- 1. Dan Clay called the meeting to order at 9:03AM
- 2. Mike Pearch conducted roll call showing the above listed members in attendance
- 3. John Birk made a motion that the current officers of the Lake Township CAG be re-elected for the 2002/2003 year. Second by Ted Walls. Motion approved.
- 4. Minutes of the 2/16/02 meeting were reviewed. One mis-spelling in 4.a.iii was corrected (rhw to the). Motion to accept the minutes as corrected made by Tom Roberts; second by John Birk. Motion approved.
