**of the Lake Township Community Advisory Group**  
**to the Board of Lake Township Trustees as to the Industrial Excess Landfill (IEL)**

Mr. JOHN BIRK moved the adoption of the following resolution which was seconded by Mr. ROY LECKOBY:

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of Lake Township, Stark County, Ohio has received a grant from the United States EPA for the purposes of exploring potential future uses for the Industrial Excess Landfill property ("IEL") and surrounding properties owned by the U.S. government ("surrounding properties") in Uniontown, Lake Township, Stark County, Ohio, and

WHEREAS pursuant to the grant, this Community Action Group known as the Lake Township Community Action Group ("CAG") has been formed for the purposes of receiving, evaluating, and commenting upon public input into the future uses of the IEL and surrounding properties, and

WHEREAS the CAG would like to explore all available opportunities as to the potential future uses of the IEL and surrounding properties

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the CAG that the group strongly recommends to the United States EPA that all necessary evaluations as to the benzene contamination at the IEL be fully and completely evaluated in an extremely expeditious manner and then remediated so that the potential future uses of the IEL property might be fully explored by the CAG in the


course of receiving, commenting upon, and evaluating community responses as to future uses for the IEL and surrounding properties;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the United States EPA upon adoption.
